RSE is a complex and vitally important area of a school's curriculum. RSE is part of the mission of Catholic schools to educate the whole person. It is to be carried out as part of the holistic education which seeks to form as well as inform young people in preparation for adult life.

Flourish is an RSE resource developed for Catholic Schools and has been adopted by the Armagh Diocese as a programme to ensure primary schools cover the **compulsory** aspect of the Primary Curriculum. The programme has been carefully looked at by all teaching staff and it has been agreed which elements will be covered, in a sensitive way. Some lessons will be covered as whole class groups, others as gender groups. From the resources you will see that not all lessons will be video led, some will be discussion based.
